

California Proposition 65 Warning Declaration

Dear customer,

California's Proposition 65 (the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986) is a California law intended to protect drinking water sources and require businesses to provide a clear and reasonable warning before exposing individuals to consumer products containing chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.


